

SAFARI NATIONAL TREK RALLY
The Third National Trek Rally
Noon Tuesday June 8, 2010 – noon Saturday June 12, 2010

As you come to the TREK rally, you will have the opportunity to have your TREK weighed on all four corners. This will give you excellent information to ensure that your TREK is balanced as you are driving down the road. Heavy loads on passenger/driver or front/back affect the tire wear and alignment.

Weighing will begin at 12 noon on Sunday June 6th and from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday & Tuesday, June 7/8th. We are NOT weighing the towed vehicles due to time constraints. Please complete this form **BEFORE YOU ARRIVE**. The form will be submitted to our weighing volunteers before you are weighed. You will receive your weights (last page of this form) immediately after weighing.

Please fill in all the information as accurately as possible. Here are some clarifying explanations for you.

- **Tire size** is in large print on the sidewall of the tire. Example 225/70 R 19.5 XRV
- **Tire Date** - The DOT# is also on the sidewall of the tire opposite the pressure information. The DOT# is a 4 digit number which refers to the week and year of manufacture. For example, 2307 = 23rd week of 2007; 1506 = 15th week of 2006. If your tires are 10 years old, then the number will be only 3 digits ending in 9 (eg, 249 = 24th week of 1999). If your tire date is more than 10 years old, the safety recommendation is 5 years or 50,000 miles. Each tire may have a different date. Please report the two front tires and the two outside rear tires. If you can get to the inner tires, report those also.
- **PlyRating** - Load range on light truck tires indicates ply rating. The code is LR (for Load Range) and either D (8 ply), E (10 ply) or F (12 ply), G (14 ply).

These are the **TREK models** that have been made over the years. Please make sure you specify the correct model for your vehicle. This information will be given back to the rally attendees as a series of analyzes based on models and years. Some information will be shared with Michelin, one of the scheduled seminars; however, there will be NO personal information in any information provided to Michelin.
