

QUARTZSITE 2021 TREK GATHERING

We ask that everyone socially distance and wear masks when visiting with others.

We are suggesting/requesting that each coach bring one bundle of insect-free/Arizona-purchased wood to share at the nightly bonfires. Firewood can also be purchased in town at multiple places so you are welcome to acquire your bundle after you have arrived at the gathering site if it is more convenient.

We plan to have at least three (maybe four if necessary) smaller fires to keep the group size down. Attendees are welcome to move from one fire to another, just wear your mask, practice distancing, and try to balance out the group sizes so they remain small.

Everyone is responsible to register with the BLM camp host. Please park and then go register at least by the next day. There is no cost, but each rig must register with the BLM individually. The best way to find the BLM Camp host is to go back up on Cholla Road and turn left onto Dome Rock Road. The ranger is about 1/4 mile up Dome Rock Rd. on the right with a large USA flag and a registration table out front.

Please sign in at the easel. Please wear a name tag so we can get to know each other. If you don't have a name tag from NWTF, SWTF or Safari International, please take a blank name tag and write your name on it. Keep it for future get-togethers.
